BeLEARN Booster Fund:

Submission, approval, and accountability of start-up phase funding applications for BeLEARN projects

The BeLEARN Fund provides seed funding for cross-institutional innovative BeLEARN projects. Individuals jointly submit applications from at least two different BeLEARN universities. Individuals from the FFHS as well as start-ups may also submit applications if at least two universities are involved in the project. Submission, approval, and accountability of projects are governed by the following.

Individuals from two or more BeLEARN universities (and possibly individuals from FFHS or start-ups) have a joint idea for a research or development project. The idea/outline is discussed with the supervisors and all members of the group „les locomotives“ according to internal university agreements.

With internal approval from the supervisors and ideally with the support of beneficiaries, start-up phase funding can be applied for. The application is made via this form and sent to booster@belearn.swiss
